



THETA 2019 Presentation Submission Guidelines

All presentation submissions involve a 1-page abstract, which must adhere to the following guidelines:

- Abstracts are to be submitted online via the [THETA presentation portal](#)
- The abstract should be a maximum of 350 words and no less than 300. Submissions that do not meet the word limit will not be reviewed.
- Abstracts should include: Author(s) details (name and affiliation) Title (of presentation), Background, Methods, Findings, and Discussion.
- Abstracts must align with one of the five Conference [sub-themes](#). The submitting presenter must nominate alignment with at least one sub-theme during submission.
- All abstracts must be submitted in electronic format.
- Only submissions submitted in English will be considered. Please ensure you thoroughly check your submission for spelling and grammatical errors as accepted abstracts will be published to the Conference website and app as per your submission.
- The submitting presenter must ensure that all co-presenters have read and approved the title, summary, presenter names and affiliations.
- Ensure that all author information (names, affiliations and presenting author biography) is included and entered correctly.
- Presenters will be notified of acceptance in December 2018 and will need to confirm their attendance and registration before 18 February 2019.
- Presenting authors are required to register for the conference. No funding is provided to presenters. Any presenter not registered for the conference by the early-bird registration deadline will not have their abstract included in the program.
